I am so grateful that we were able to jump onto the Penn State block booking to bring Jacob Kelley/Trixy Valentine to our campus. While we did not have the turnout we anticipated, Trixy was able to pivot and command the space in an engaging and vibrant way. The trivia was intentional, and not only challenged students (and staff) that participated, but also provided context, understanding, and empathy for how long the LGBTQ+ community has been fighting for their rights in a way that brought everyone IN to the conversation, instead of feeling like we were being talked AT. The most humbling and eye opening fact, that I have continued to reflect on since the event- is that 2023 has seen the most anti-LGBT legislation in the history of the US and gay rights movements: challenging our beliefs that the discrimination and violence toward this community is a past tense problem, not a current tense problem.
